Pre-Entering is for the following reasons:

Pre-Entering will help us determine if we have enough entries to hold the show, which in turn will help the exhibitor find another show to attend if their division is not going to fill.

Pre-Entering will help us decide if we can have a later start time. Everyone loves being able to sleep a little later.

Pre-Entering helps us know how much food the concession stand needs to buy.

Pre-Entering gives the secretary time to process the entries ahead of time instead of being rushed the morning of the show.

Pre-Entering will help us determine approximately what time each division will start.

Pre-Entering will help us know how to reach you if we need to cancel the show.

SPECIFICATIONS

Warm-Up - to be run before each division.

Breeding - To be judged on the line for hunter suitability.

Lead-Line - Riders 8 years and younger.

Baby Green - Horses and ponies who have not shown more than twice prior to the December 1, 2009.

Open Hunter - Horses or ponies. Rider chooses height of fences.

Green Hunter - Horses and ponies. Horses may be in their first or second year of showing over fences. Rider chooses height of fences. Will be split horses and ponies if entries warrant.

Special Junior/Amateur Hunter - Juniors and Amateurs. Cross entering is allowed. Fences 2'.

Junior/Amateur Hunter - Will be split if entries warrant. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

Pony Hunter - Will be split if entries warrant. Small - 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6".

THSA/VHSA Equitation - Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Will be split by Junior, Amateur and/or Pony if entries warrant.

Pleasure - Horses and ponies. Classes will be Walk-Trot Pleasure, Walk-Trot-Canter Pleasure, and Go As You Please. If entries warrant class will be split by horses and ponies, juniors, amateurs, green.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Horses and ponies ridden by children 12 years and under. The division will consist of three (3) classes, two over fence classes and a walk, trot, canter under saddle class. Short Stirrup riders, ponies and horses may not cross enter into any other VHSA Associate Division with the exception of Pleasure Pony or Pleasure Horse. Fences will be 18".

Beginner - Horses and ponies ridden by juniors or adults in their first or second year of showing over fences OR riders who are just coming back to showing over fences. Two classes will be simple courses which can be trotted or cantered. First class will be walk, trot, canter.

Walk-Trot Equitation - Juniors and Amateurs in their first or second year of showing.

Mock IHSA Classes - open to riders who are on or have been on a college equestrian team. To have the same requirements as classes at an IHSA show. Riders will draw the horse they show prior to the start of the Mock IHSA classes. RIDERS MUST BE PRE-ENTERED BY MONDAY BEFORE THE SHOW. Classes will be determined by the riders entered.
