Pre-Entering will help us decide if we can have a later start time. Everyone loves being able to sleep a little later.

Pre-Entering helps us know how much food the concession stand needs to buy.

Pre-Entering gives the secretary time to process the entries ahead of time instead of being rushed the morning of the show.

Pre-Entering will help us determine approximately what time each division will start.

Pre-Entering will help us know how to reach you if we need to cancel the show.

Rules and General Information

1. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes
2. Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded in each division
3. **EVERYONE MUST WEAR A HARD HAT WHEN MOUNTED**
4. The Judges decisions are Final.
5. **All dogs must be on a leash at all times.**
6. Current Coggins required and will be checked at the secretary's desk.
7. **Appropriate Attire Recommended**

Conditions of entry- — Participants realize and accept the inherent risk of an equine activity. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of show Management but Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the show, the Management, and the Facility harmless for any loss or accident to his or her horse, horses, or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Ref. VA code Ann. S 3.1-796.130 (1994)

Management — *Reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising from an incident at the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Mgmt., and their decision is final. Mgmt. reserves to itself the right to cancel or combine classes or to reschedule classes.*

Discourtesy — *to an official by any spectator, rider, trainer, or groom will disqualify the horse or horses with which they are associated and all fees will be forfeited.*

Be sure to check with us on Friday before the show to see the status of the show. Schedule will be revised according to the classes that fill.

SPECIFICATIONS

TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE

Warm-Up - to be run before each division.

Breeding - To be judged on the line for Hunter Suitability.

Lead Line- 8 years and younger.

Baby Green- Open to horses and ponies who have not shown more than twice prior to Dec 1 2009.

Open Hunter- Open to horses and ponies—rider chooses height of fences.

Green Hunter- Open to horses and ponies. Horses may be in their 1st/2nd year of showing over fences. Rider chooses height of fences. Will be split (horses & ponies) if entries warrant.

Special Junior/ Amateur Hunter - Open to all Juniors and Amateurs. Cross-entering is allowed. Fences 2'

Pony Hunter- Will be split if entries warrant.

THSA/VHSA Equitation- Open to Juniors/Amateurs on horses or ponies. Will be split by Juniors/Amateurs and/or pony if entries warrant.

Short Stirrup Hunter- Open to horses and ponies ridden by children 12 yrs and under. Division will consist of 3 classes. Two over fences classes and a walk/trot/canter under saddle class. Short Stirrup Riders ponies and horses may not cross enter into any other VHSA Associate Division with the exception of Pleasure Horse or Pleasure Pony. Fences will be 18".

Beginner Equitation- Riders in their first/second year of showing over fences. Two classes will be simple courses—can be trotted or cantered. Third class will be walk/trot/canter.

Walk/Trot Equitation- Juniors/Amateurs in first/second year of showing—Will be split younger/older if entries warrant.

Pleasure- Open to horses and ponies. Classes will be walk/trot pleasure, walk/trot/canter pleasure, and go as you please. If entries warrant, classes will be split by horses, ponies, juniors, amateurs, and green.
